Installation information

With Sage 300 Construction and Real Estate

If you are upgrading from an earlier version, you must install Sage 300 Construction and Real Estate version 15.1 and Accounting update 7 before you install Sage Estimating version 15.1 and Estimating update 7.

If you already are using Sage 300 Construction and Real Estate version 15.1, install Accounting update 7 before you install Estimating update 7.

Without Sage 300 Construction and Real Estate

If you are upgrading from an earlier version of Sage Estimating, install version 15.1 and then Estimating update 7.

If you already are using Sage Estimating version 15.1, just install Estimating update 7.

The initial release of Sage Estimating version 15.1 does not contain any major changes.

Windows 10 is now a supported operating system, in addition to Windows 8.1 and earlier.

About the updates

Estimating updates are required for compatibility with Sage 300 Construction and Real Estate 15.1 updates. No other changes were made in updates 1 - 4, 6, and 7.

Changes in update 5

Improved spreadsheet performance

In the Estimate spreadsheet, we have improved the performance of scrolling and data entry when estimates include several items that contain subcontractors.

Fixes

Estimating Explorer issues resolved

Estimating Explorer now runs on Windows 8.1, Windows 10, and Windows Server 2012. On these newer operating systems, the Estimating install prompts you to install SQL Server 2012 Express. If you do not use Estimating Explorer or plan to use an existing instance, do not install SQL Server 2012 Express. Otherwise, have the installer install SQL Server 2012 Express.
